# Issues, End of Term and Dress Code

I am writing to bring a couple of issues to your attention and to outline some of the activities for the end of term. For the majority of parents the first two items are not an issue for your child but as I don't know who might fall foul of these on any given day I need to inform all parents and carers.

## Issues:

We are still experiencing a number of students arriving late, whilst this has improved significantly since I last wrote, it is still a daily issue for us. Lessons start promptly at 8.40am - this means all students need to be on site and in corridors BEFORE then. Please can your child be past the school gates by 8.35am to ensure they can get to lessons or study sessions on time.
