Spreading infection due to touch, sneezes and coughs		<p>Handwashing facilities will be provided. Within the classroom a sanitisation station is available for the use of occupants.</p> <p>Hand sanitisers will be available at reception, student entrance into school, outside the medical room, washrooms, in corridors and the canteen area.</p> <p>Windows will be kept open wherever possible and practicable as will doors.</p> <p>Everyone in school will be strongly encouraged to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Frequently wash their hands with soap and water for 20 seconds and dry thoroughly using NHS guidelines, or use alcohol-based hand sanitiser to cover all parts of their hands ● Clean their hands on arrival, before and after eating, and after sneezing or coughing ● Be encouraged not to touch their mouth, eyes and nose ● Use a tissue or elbow to cough or sneeze, and use bins for tissue waste. ● Students will be encouraged to learn and practise these habits in lessons and by posters put up across the school. <p>Staff and students can wear face masks in communal areas if they wish however these will not be expected in lessons.</p> <p>Supplies for soap, hand sanitiser and disposable paper towels and tissues will be topped up regularly and monitored to make sure they're not close to running out.</p> <p>Lidded bins for tissues, operated by a foot pedal, will be emptied throughout the day.</p>	<p>Site Staff</p> <p>All staff/ students</p> <p>Site/ Cleaning team</p>	<p>25.08.2021</p> <p>25.08.2021</p>	

<p>Spreading infection through contact with coronavirus on surfaces</p>		<p>Cleaning staff will regularly clean frequently touched surfaces using standard cleaning products (e.g. bleach, detergent), including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Banisters ● Washroom facilities (including taps and flush buttons) ● Door and window handles ● Light switches ● Reception desks ● Teaching and learning aids ● Computer equipment (including keyboards and mouse) ● Sports equipment ● Telephones ● Water coolers <p>Items that need laundering (e.g. towels, tea towels and cleaning clothes) will be washed regularly in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, on the warmest water setting. These items will not be shared between students between washes.</p> <p>Areas of the school that are used by students will be cleaned thoroughly at the end of the day.
