

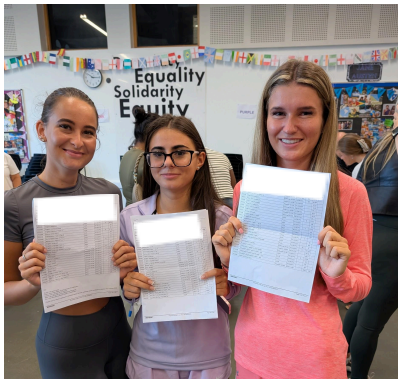
DSTC Year 11 Results 2025 - Press Release

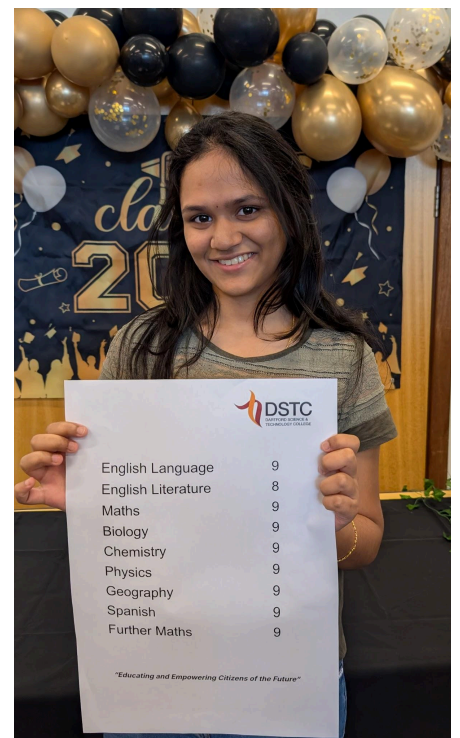
We are also thrilled to see exceptional performance in both English and Maths. Well done, everyone. We're so proud of you all.
